

DONCASTER CLASSIC CAR & BIKE SHOW 2022

Frequently asked questions about the event

Exhibitors and Traders at the event

Q – How do I book to come along?

A – Traders and Exhibitors book by visiting our online booking site via - www.doncasterclassiccarshow.org

Q – How do I get a car or motorcycle club discount when booking

A - If you intend to exhibit as part of a club entry please contact your club organiser – they will make one application on behalf of those members attending via the Exhibitor Club Booking options on our website Show Booking page. Otherwise, you will need to apply as a single exhibitor at a cost of £6.00 for a car or £4 for a bike/motorcycle.

Q - Can I pay when I arrive, instead of pre-booking?

A - Traders MUST have pre-booked and paid. All Exhibitors are requested to pre-book to ensure display space on the day. Others wishing to exhibit their vehicles may be able to gain entry on the day providing advanced bookings have not filled the site. You will need to check the website regularly to ascertain if there are still places. The Organisers cannot be held responsible if someone arrives in an exhibiting vehicle that has not been pre-booked, and then cannot gain entry.

Q - What extras do I need to pay for after paying for entry?

A - Once you have paid for entry, there are no other mandatory payments.

Q - Does my entry payment cover anyone else in the vehicle?

A - Entry payment is for the exhibiting vehicle inclusive of driver and up to 3 passengers.

Q - Can any other friends or family accompany us in their vehicle(s)?

A – Unless they have pre-booked as part of a club display, others will need to park in one of the two public car parks (free of charge) on site and then walk into the event, paying on entry as pedestrians.

Q – If I have to cancel my attendance before the event, can I obtain a refund?

A – Payments are to be regarded as a donation to the Rotary Club of Doncaster St George's Charitable Trust. In the event of Exhibitor/Traders cancellations, payments will NOT be refunded.

Q - Is the show easily accessible for my vehicle?

A - The show entrance is on Stadium Way, on Lakeside, Doncaster, DN4 5JW, easily accessible and sign-posted off the M18 motorway (junction 3), Bawtry Road, Doncaster (A638) or White Rose Way (A6182). Once entering Car Park No. 2, follow the signs and/or Marshals) clockwise around the main stadium building.

Q - Will it be possible to temporarily exit the event and not have to pay again to reenter?

A - For individuals wishing to walk out, we will provide pass-outs in the form of a hand stamp. It will NOT be possible to allow vehicles to exit and reenter.

Q – Am I allowed to bring pets into the show?

A - We allow access to domestic pets providing they are kept on a lead, always under control and they and their owners don't cause concern or damage to other people or possessions present. It is also the responsibility of pet owners to clean up any mess they create.

Q - Am I allowed to bring my own refreshments into the show?

A - There are no restrictions on bringing food and drink, providing they are for your personal consumption and those accompanying you. Unless a designated (and pre-booked) Trader, you are not allowed to sell refreshments to other members of the general public.

Q - Am I able to hold a picnic for myself and other members of my family/friends?

A - Yes, providing you do not intrude on other visitors. We do NOT allow BBQs however.

Q - What refreshments are available at the show?

A - A full complement of items will be available, from tea and coffee to canned drinks, from hot and cold snacks, to more fulfilling meals, plus a fully licensed bar. Some traders will also be selling retail chocolates and sweets as well as fresh and bottled/boxed items of food.

Q – Am I allowed to bring and operate a generator to power any facilities I may need?

A – The use of small super-silenced generators is permitted. When booking, proof will be required that all such items have current P.A.T certification, a copy of which should be brought with you on the day.

Q – Do I need insurance cover to attend the event?

A – Traders MUST have public liability cover (see our Terms & Conditions) and Exhibitors must have their vehicles correctly insured, copies of which should be brought with you on the day.

Q - Are there any indoor areas to shelter during inclement weather?

A - Limited space is available inside the outer limits of the stadium where the licensed bar and toilets are situated.

Q - Can I take photographs and videos during the event?

A - The only restriction on taking any photographic record is where a specific vehicle owner or members of a family, object. You should not take photographs of people without their permission.

Q - Are there any restrictions relating to the recent pandemic?

A - The Organisers will follow national Government guidelines at the time.

Q - What time does the event close?

A - The official finish time is 4pm, at which time pedestrians and visitors may start to exit the site. Please follow any instructions and signage, limiting speed to 5mph and giving priority to pedestrians to ensure maximum safety. The site must be cleared by 5.30pm.

Q - Is it possible to remove my vehicle from the site before 4pm?

A - Under extreme circumstances, agreed with the Organisers on the day, this may be possible. Otherwise, vehicles must remain until 4pm, to avoid any safety issues with pedestrians.

Q – What is the maximum size of vehicle I can bring along to exhibit?

A – Standard Exhibitor pitch sizes are 6m width x 3m width. Owners of larger vehicles and clubs, should identify their requirements when booking. Bikes and trikes will all be parked together, ensuring sufficient space is left in case of any falling over.

Q – What size are the trader pitches?

A – A standard pitch is 7m x 5m, with multiple pitches available if required.

Q – Is there a programme of activities and other information to refer to once at the show?

A – A quality programme will be issued free to all visitors and exhibitors upon entry. This will contain a plan of the site and other information required during your stay.

Q – Where does the profit go that is raised at the event?

A – This money goes into the Rotary Club of Doncaster St George's Charitable Trust fund, for ongoing distribution to other charities and good causes.
