

# DONCASTER CLASSIC CAR & BIKE SHOW

## **Information for Traders**

We have great pleasure in inviting you to attend and trade at the Doncaster Classic Car & Bike Show 2023 at the Eco Power Stadium on Lakeside, Doncaster.

We have significant on-site free parking for visitors allowing easy access. We expect this, together with an excellent full day of entertainment and extensive catering and bar facilities, to result in another highly successful event. Our annual show encourages up to 800 exhibiting vehicles and up to 5,000 members of the general public attending during the day.

All our Trader pitches are outdoors, but in close proximity to all facilities, at a cost of just £30 per plot. Each plot will measure approximately 7m x 5m, sufficient to comfortably hold a standard 3m x 3m gazebo, with space to sit, trade and hold stock. If you require more space, multiple plots may be booked.

### **IMPORTANT NOTICE**

**Traders will need to provide their own tables, chairs, power and gazebos. All pitches will be situated on grass, so will need a method of securing gazebos, etc., to the ground. Entry for a vehicle and up to 3 accompanying persons is included with each plot pre-booked online. Entry permits will be provided automatically to download, to be displayed prominently in vehicle windscreens upon arrival for scanning.**

The site opens to Traders from 7.30am on Show-day. Traders must be on site and fully operational before 10am when the event opens to the general public. Entry to the site is off Stadium Way, opposite the Lakeside Shopping Centre.

Applications for Trader plots online will close at a set date (identified when booking). If full, a booking will be entered on to a Waiting List, and those waiting will be informed as soon as a plot becomes available. The Organisers reserve the right to refuse any application. All plots must be pre-booked.

We do require confirmation of Third Party/Public Liability insurance when booking, and evidence prior to the event via email or post, as a condition of booking. Traders should also have copies available on the day. We would urge Traders to undertake your own risk assessment.

By ticking the appropriate box, you agree to them, which then allows you to book your space. You will receive an email confirmation of your booking, your ticket(s) to download and we will keep you informed of any other information by email, prior to the event.

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## **Frequently Asked Questions**

### **Q - Does my entry payment cover anyone else in the vehicle?**

A - Entry payment is for the traders vehicle(s) inclusive of driver and passengers who will be working on their stand(s). Other family and friends must pay on entry.

### **Q – If I have to cancel my attendance before the event, can I obtain a refund?**

A – Payments are to be regarded as a donation to the Rotary Club of Doncaster St George's Charitable Trust. In the event of Exhibitor/Traders cancellations, payments will NOT be refunded.

### **Q - Is the show easily accessible for my vehicle?**

A - The show entrance is on Stadium Way, on Lakeside, Doncaster, DN4 5JW, easily accessible and signposted off the M18 motorway (junction 3), Bawtry Road, Doncaster (A638) or White Rose Way (A6182). Once entering Car Park No. 2, follow the signs and/or Marshals) clockwise around the main stadium building.

### **Q - Will it be possible to temporarily exit the event and not have to pay again to reenter?**

A - For individuals wishing to walk out, we will provide pass-outs in the form of a hand stamp. It will NOT be possible to allow vehicles to exit and reenter.

### **Q – Am I allowed to bring pets into the show?**

A - We allow access to domestic pets providing they are kept on a lead, always under control and they and their owners don't cause concern or damage to other people or possessions present. It is also the responsibility of pet owners to clean up any mess they create.

### **Q - Am I allowed to bring my own refreshments into the show?**

A - There are no restrictions on bringing food and drink, providing they are for your personal consumption and those accompanying you. Only designated (and pre-booked) Traders, are allowed to sell refreshments to other members of the general public.

### **Q - Am I able to hold a picnic for myself and other members of my family/friends?**

A - Yes, providing you do not intrude on other visitors. We do NOT allow BBQs however.

### **Q - What refreshments are available at the show?**

A - A full complement of items will be available, from tea and coffee to canned drinks, from hot and cold snacks, to more fulfilling meals, plus a fully licensed bar. Some Traders will also be selling retail chocolates and sweets as well as fresh and bottled/boxed items of food.

### **Q – Am I allowed to bring and operate a generator to power any facilities I may need?**

A – The use of small super-silenced generators is permitted. When booking, prove will be required that all such items have current P.A.T certification, a copy of which should be brought with you on the day.

### **Q – Do I need insurance cover at attend the event?**

Traders MUST have public liability cover (see our Terms & Conditions) and their vehicles correctly insured, copies of which should be brought with you on the day.

### **Q - Are there any indoor areas to shelter during inclement weather?**

A - Limited space is available inside the outer limits of the stadium where the licensed bar and toilets are situated.

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**Q - Can I take photographs and videos during the event?**

A - The only restriction on taking any photographic record is where a specific vehicle owner or members of a family, object. You should not take photographs of people without their permission.

**Q - Are there any restrictions relating to the recent pandemic?**

A - The Organisers will follow national Government guidelines at the time.

**Q - What time does the event close?**

A - The official finish time is 4pm, at which time pedestrians and visitors may start to exit the site. Please follow any instructions and signage, limiting speed to 5mph and giving priority to pedestrians to ensure maximum safety. The site must be cleared by 5.30pm.

**Q - Is it possible to remove my vehicle from the site before 4pm?**

A - Under extreme circumstances, agreed with the Organisers on the day, this may be possible. Otherwise, vehicles must remain until 4pm, to avoid any safety issues with pedestrians. Traders, upon setting up their pitches, may opt to park their vehicles in public car park No. 2 if desired.

**Q - What size are the trader pitches?**

A - A standard pitch is 7m x 5m, with multiple pitches available if required.

**Q - Is there a programme of activities and other information to refer to once at the show?**

A - A quality programme will be issued free to everyone upon entry. This will contain a plan of the site and other information required during your stay.

**Q - Where does the profit go that is raised at the event?**

A - This money goes into the Rotary Club of Doncaster St George's Charitable Trust fund, for ongoing distribution to other charities and good causes.

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
