Trader – General Terms and Conditions

It is important you read and understand the following General Terms & Conditions to which you are bound as part of your contract with the Organisers. Please read the note at the foot of these terms and conditions and if you are in any doubt as to your responsibilities, or the meaning of any of the following provisions, you should seek legal advice.

The following terms and meanings apply unless the context specifically requires otherwise.

<u>Term</u>	<u>Meaning</u>
Eco	The Eco Power stadium
Marshals	Members of the Rotary Club of Doncaster St George's, their volunteers and assistants, security and other staff of Eco.
Organisers	Rotary Club of Doncaster St George's.
Show	The Doncaster Classic Car and Bike Show to be held between 7.00am and 4.00pm on Saturday 8th July 2023.
Showground	The facilities at the Eco Power stadium, Lakeside, Doncaster, used for this event.
Trader	Unless the context otherwise admits, the Trader entering into this agreement

THE PLOT

Each outdoor plot constitutes approximately 7 metres by 5 metres. A request for a larger plot may be considered for an increased fee, if booked in advance (before 15th June). Any vehicles or trailers, including draw-bars, which remain on a booked pitch during the Show, must be wholly contained within the space allotted. Failure to do so will result in the Trader being required to relocate the trailer, vehicle or other obstruction to an alternate location within the facility, as directed by a Marshal.

Traders must not bring onto the Showground any noxious, dangerous, toxic or inflammable liquids or substances, without the prior approval in writing of the Organisers.

No trader may sub-let any part of their allocated plot without written permission from the Organisers. Traders must not sell pre-cooked or hot food or drink for consumption at the show, unless by prior arrangement with the Organisers.

Traders may only carry out the trade as described on their booking. Traders must ensure they observe all laws and regulations pertaining to that Trade.

ACCESS TO SHOWGROUND AND SHOW TIMES

Traders will only be admitted to the Showground and remain for the Show, if an online booking, full payment and a declaration of Public Liability Insurance has been received and accepted by the Organisers.

The Showground will be open to Traders from 7.30am on the day of the Show, or earlier IF previously agreed in writing. All deliveries of implements, goods, tents and other materials to the Showground must be completed by 9.45am. No delivery by vehicle on to the site is permissible after that time, although goods may be brought in from the outside parking areas.

Public entry is at 10.00am. All stands must be operational by this time and manned throughout the day. No stand may be dismantled before 4.00pm.

All plots and adjacent areas must be left clean, tidy and completely cleared of all rubbish and debris

VEHICLES

Traders must drive slowly, carefully and any directions given by the Marshals on site must be observed. Maximum speed on the Showground is limited to 5mph and Traders must accept that pedestrians have the right of way. Vehicle movements are not permitted between 9.45am and 4.00pm

POWER

The use of small, super-silenced portable generators will be permitted. Please indicate this requirement when booking. All electrical items must have current P.A.T Certification and evidence of that certification must be available for inspection at the Show by the Organisers or representatives of Eco. Failure to produce a current P.A.T Certificate will render use of the equipment in question prohibited. Whilst a current P.A.T Certificate must be available, Traders must also ensure their electrical equipment is safe to use and will not cause a hazard or risk to other users of the Showground.

FIRE SAFETY

An appropriate and fully functioning fire extinguisher must be provided on any stand using naked flames, electrical equipment or other sources of heat or ignition or other use requiring such safeguards. A no smoking policy must be adhered to in any enclosed spaces.

GAZEBOS, TENTS, MARQUEES ETC

Each Trader will have to provide their own tables, chairs and gazebos etc. All Trader plots are outdoor on grassed areas. Traders must ensure that none of their equipment (including cabling and the like), creates tripping or other hazards to other users of the Showground. Any gazebos, tents or marquees erected must be secured without causing any damage to the hard-standing.

ANIMALS

Domestic animals are permitted, adequate measures must be taken to ensure they do not become a danger/hazard to other users of the Showground and owners/keepers must clean up after their animals.

SECURITY

Although some security will operate throughout the Showground, neither the Organisers nor Eco will accept any responsibility for any theft, damage, vandalism or loss whatsoever that may occur, or which the Trader suffers.

Breach of any of the Contract terms and these General Terms & Conditions or behaviour likely in the opinion of the Organiser's Chief Steward to cause nuisance or disturbance or any fear or concern for visitors or others, may lead to the Trader having to leave the Show. By attending the Show, the Trader agrees there will be no such breach or behaviour and that in the event he is required to leave the Show at the request of the Chief Steward, he will leave the Showground in a safe and orderly manner, removing his equipment and stock and other possessions and otherwise complying with the terms of this Contract.

HEALTH & SAFETY

Traders are reminded that they are responsible for observance by themselves, their employees and their contractors of the Health & Safety at Work (etc) Act 1974 and all relevant statutory provisions that

cover all Safety Regulations provided by the Health and Safety Executive. These requirements will be enforced by the Local Authority Inspectors and Safety Officer who is also able to offer advice.

All health and safety matters are the responsibility of the Trader.

All Traders must observe the Health and Safety Rules applicable to the site. Breach of these rules may result in the Trader having to leave the Showground. Traders are encouraged to undertake a risk assessment for this Show.

RIGHTS, LIABILITIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARTIES

The Organisers...

(a) will not be responsible for any article, plant, machinery or any object of any kind present, exhibited or sold or gifted or the consequences of the acts or omissions of any other person or incidents or events connected with any item or thing on the Showground, or any resulting direct or other loss. The Trader shall assume full responsibility and liability for all damage, loss and any claims arising out of the trade, sale or exhibition, handling, or housing of such articles, plant, machinery or objects and the conduct of the Trader within and around the plot and otherwise within the Showground generally.

(b) will not be responsible for any damage to any vehicle brought by the Trader onto the Showground from whatever cause and howsoever arising.

(c) will not be in any way liable to persons whatsoever for any damage or loss, however caused to the property of such person or for any injury, fatal or otherwise to any such person while on the Showground or while entering or leaving the same.

(d) shall not be liable to compensate the Trader in any way arising from any error in the apportionment of space or for any encroachment by any person onto any pitch of the Trader or in the event that the right of the Trader to remain on the Showground is terminated for any reason.

The Trader...

(a) shall indemnify the Organisers and Eco in respect of all claims, losses, injuries, disease, damages or expenses whatsoever in any way arising from the acts, omissions, or presence of the Trader or his vehicle, equipment, stock or exhibits on the Showground including any legal costs or experts fees incurred.

(b) must provide the Organiser with a declaration of public liability insurance which covers the Trader in respect of his activities or trade to be carried out on the date of the Show. Traders must bring such evidence on the day of the Show and produce it when requested. Failure to do so may result in the

Trader having to leave the Showground and no compensation or refund shall be payable to the trader in those circumstances.

(c) shall be solely liable for any loss, injury or damage that may be done to or occasioned by or arise from any article or property exhibited by or brought onto the Showground by him or for him and shall indemnify the Organisers and Eco (to the full extent as though they were a party to this contract) on account of, or in respect of such damage or injury which may be so caused. Traders shall be liable for the behaviour and for any misconduct or negligence of their agents, employees, servants, contractors, volunteers and helpers and the consequences thereof, including all direct or indirect losses, and the said liability and indemnity shall extend to the acts or omissions of such parties.

Refusal of entry to the Showground due to any breach of these Terms and Conditions does not give rise to any liability to pay compensation to the Trader or refund any monies paid by the Trader.

These terms and conditions are considered by the Organisers to be fair and reasonable having regard to the circumstances of and the risks inherent in and incidental upon the holding of the Show. By entry into this Agreement the Trader acknowledges the fairness and reasonableness of these Terms and Conditions.
